

LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

- Beyond any fence or line of white stakes defining the boundary of the course
- On or beyond the Military Road
- 4th and 5th Holes – Within the post marking the reservoir area, except when the winter tee on the reservoir is in use
- 4th, 17th and 18th Holes – On or beyond the access road to the reservoir

GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25)

Relief MUST BE TAKEN from

- All areas affected by the installation or repair of irrigation pipes
- A wrong putting green
- Any areas as defined on the golf course by the use of GUR signs and white lines / rope / stakes

Relief may be taken from

- Hoof marks
- Vehicle tracks
- Tining holes on greens

MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 21-1)

- Stones in bunkers
- Fairway marker posts
- Ropes and metal stakes used to direct traffic flow

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)

- The Tennyson Trail (the right of way running through the middle of the Course)

- Chalk or stone when a ball lies thereon
- All fixed sprinkler heads and valve control covers
- Fixed sprinkler heads within two club lengths of the green that intervene on the line of play between the hole and a ball which lies on a closely mown area within two club lengths of the sprinkler head
- Ropes and wooden stakes used to direct traffic flow
- All fixed course furniture such as tee information boards, benches, bins

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES (Rule 14-3)

Devices used to measure distance (but distance only) are permitted.

BALL ACCIDENTALLY MOVED ON PUTTING GREEN

Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1 are modified as follows:

"When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1.

This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental."

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced.
